The Black and Missing Foundation and Liberty Christian Church To Provide Free Self Defense Classes for Youth Ages 5-17 Beginning April 1

What: In light of the heightened awareness of missing children in the District of

Columbia, on Saturday, April 1, the Black and Missing Foundation (BAMFI) in partnership with Liberty Christian Church will offer a FREE self-defense class for youth ages 5-17. The class will provide the participants vital techniques and skills on how to protect themselves. The April 1st class is the

first in a series of self-defense trainings that will be offered during the spring

and summer months.
